Maths	1 task a week.	Set on Monday.

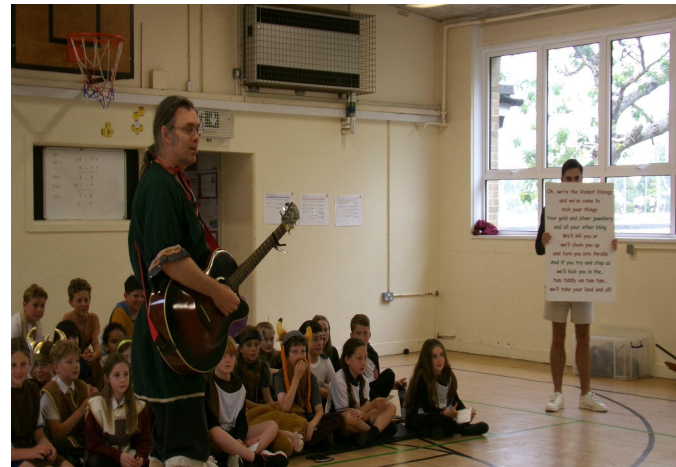
# Homework expectations
